

CONSTITUTION OF THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND
(INTERIM),
B.E. 2557
AMENDMENT (NO. 3),
B.E. 2559 (2016)

BHUMIBOL ADULYADEJ, REX.
Given on the 30th Day of August B.E. 2559;
Being the 71st Year of the Present Reign.

His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej is graciously pleased to proclaim that:
Whereas it is expedient to amend the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand
(Interim), B.E. 2557 (2014);

Be it, therefore, enacted by the King the Constitution of the Kingdom of
Thailand (Interim), B.E. 2557 Amendment, as follows:

Section 1. This Constitution is called the “Constitution of the Kingdom of
Thailand (Interim), B.E. 2557 Amendment (No. 3), B.E. 2559 (2016)”.

Section 2. This Constitution shall come into force as from the day following
the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.

Section 3. The provisions of section 6 paragraph one of the Constitution of
the Kingdom of Thailand (Interim), B.E. 2557 (2014) shall be repealed and replaced by the
following:

“Section 6. There shall be a National Legislative Assembly consisting of not
more than two hundred and fifty members appointed by the King, upon the advice of the
National Council for Peace and Order, from persons of Thai nationality by birth who is not less
than forty years of age”.

Section 4. Members of the National Legislative Assembly holding office on the
day before the date of the promulgation of this Constitution shall be members of the National

Legislative Assembly under the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand (Interim), B.E. 2557 (2014) as amended by this Constitution.
